23 June 2025 (Hong Kong) – Following the announcement of *Star Voyager's* extended deployment in Hong Kong through 14 November 2025, StarCruises is delighted to unveil a vibrant line-up of both new and well-loved itineraries. Sailing weekly from the conveniently located Hong Kong Ocean Terminal, *Star Voyager* will now offer a total of 45 sailings during its more than five-month homeport stay in Hong Kong.
